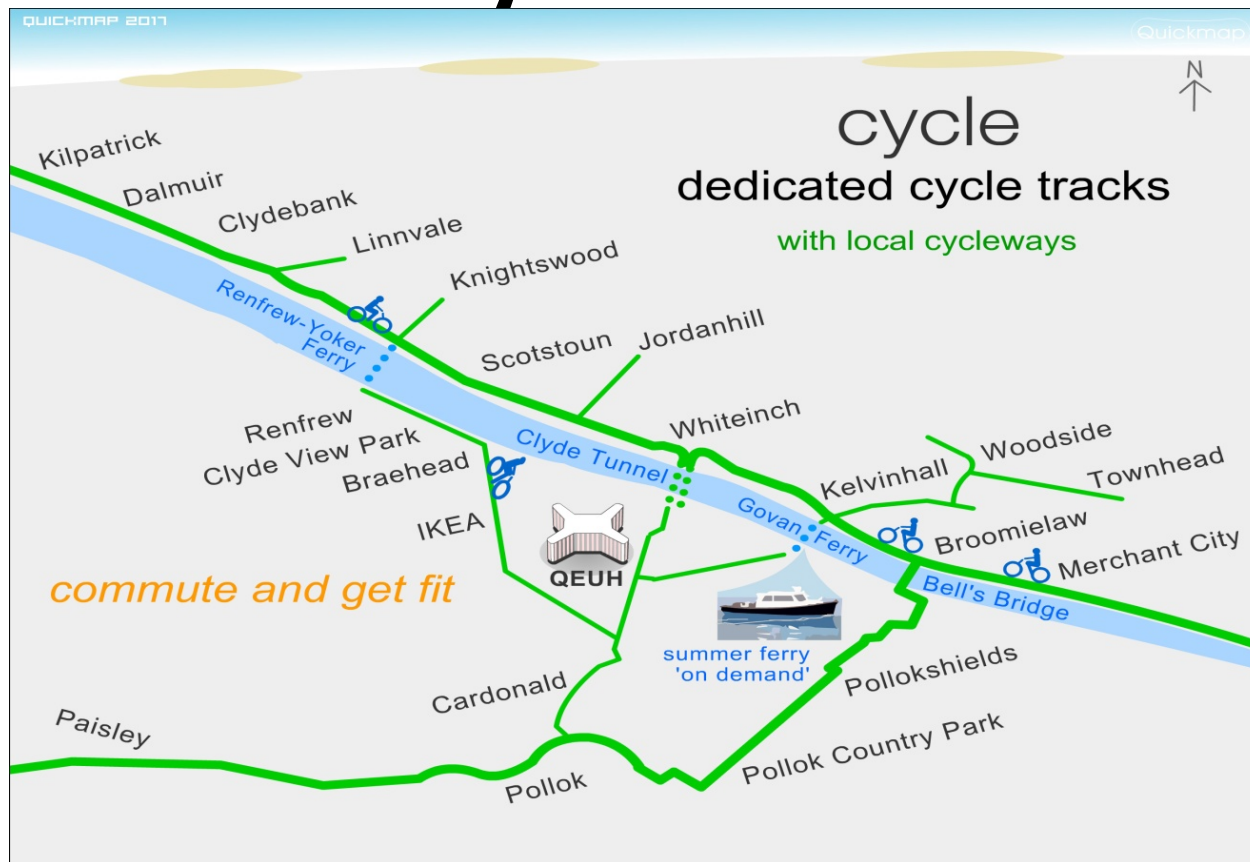


Free Govan Ferry - Summer 2017

WG ACH and QEUH/RHC
FREE FERRY 30th June - September 2017

The FREE ferry between Govan and the Riverside Museum returns on 30th June 2017 and will run daily until Doors Open Day in September.

Operating Hours: 8am – 6pm Monday to Friday, 10.00am – 5.30pm at the weekends.

Where: Departures from the pontoons at the bottom of Water Row & at Riverside Museum. This is a shuttle service therefore turn up when you are ready to set sail as the ferry will be ‘shuttling’ backwards and forwards continually throughout the day.

- Excellent opportunity for staff based at **West Glasgow ACH and QEUH/RHC** to cross the Clyde for free as part of their commute.
- The crossing can be used to visit the Riverside Museum, the Tall Ship or the West End of Glasgow as well as the newly displayed Govan Stones in Govan Old Parish Church, the Govan Saturday market, or see what else Govan has to offer.

Please encourage colleagues to make use of this free service while you have the chance. The river crossing between Govan & Partick will run until the proposed bridge is in place (scheduled Summer 2020).
