### Continuation of the LHCC Professional Advisory Committee

#### Recommendation:

- the Board approve the continuation of the LHCC Professional Advisory Committee pending the full establishment of Community Health Partnerships and their related advisory arrangements.

#### A. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE

- 1.1 The LHCC Professional Advisory Committee brings together representatives from all of the professional groups within primary care. It has an important role in developing policy for the LHCCs and through its Chair in contributing to thinking at the NHS Board.
- 1.2 The purpose of this paper is to propose that the LHCC Professional Advisory Committee continues to meet until we have finalised and established the Community Health Partnerships and their associated advisory arrangements. This proposal will give a clear message to primary care contractors and staff that the Board continues to value their views and advice as we move to the detailed discussion beyond the outline schemes of establishment for Community Health Partnerships.

#### B. CONCLUSION

- 2.1 Until revised organisational arrangements are in place the LHCC Professional Advisory Committee should continue as at present.
