General Information

Due to the ongoing building work on the hospital site, car access to the building is carefully controlled. **Please read this information carefully.**

Please follow the walking route signs from either the multistorey car park or the main hospital drive (from Govan Road) which will direct you to the front door of the building. See map overpage.

The Clinical Genetics reception and the clinic area are on the 1st floor of the Laboratory Medicine building. There is a lift.

Disabled Parking

Parking for blue badge holders is available within the multistorey car park. For most people, this takes about 5 minutes to walk but for those with mobility problems it may take longer. There are 3 spaces directly outside the door of the department but these may be occupied. If necessary, it is possible to be dropped at the door, **but you need to arrange this in advance to allow access to the area**. If you are a blue badge holder and cannot be dropped off but would need access to a parking space immediately outside, please contact us to see if we can arrange this. Please phone our Clinic Nurse on **0141 354 9207** well in advance of your appointment, or speak to Reception on **0141 354 9200** if the Clinic Nurse is not available.

Facilities available within the Department

- We can arrange an interpreter or British Sign Language interpreter. If you require an interpreter please let us know as soon as possible to allow us to arrange this.
- We have Portable Hearing Loop and other amplified hearing equipment. These can be used for both hearing and non hearing aid users.

If you need any of the above please contact our clinic nurse or reception.

Other facilities include

• Toilets including accessible toilet with nappy changing facilities are available.

Please note there is no hoist or adequate nursing staff to operate a hoist within the department. If this would create a problem, we can arrange to see you in a suitable area with these facilities, again contact the clinic nurse in advance as above.

There are vending machines on the ground floor, and a Café in the Neurosciences building.
