

CANCER PLANNING FRAMEWORK 2014-15 UPDATE

Relevant changes to the national and local context

- The national Transforming Care After Treatment Programme, launched 2013 sets out to develop strategies and initiatives to improve cancer survivorship.

Areas which require additional or particular focus for year 2

- **Year 2 priority: early Intervention and preventing ill health:**
 - demonstrating how prevention and self management is embedded into clinical pathways particularly focusing on mapping pathway, increasing referrals and training frontline staff. This work links with the Health Improvement Policy Framework.
- **Year 2 priority: quality, effectiveness and efficiency:**
 - the Board, in conjunction with the West of Scotland Planning Group and SGHD, are actively progressing future planning assumptions for radiotherapy capacity across the central belt. The WoSSRC Outline Business Case (OBC) was approved by the Health Directorates Capital Investment Group (CIG) in August 2013 and the West of Scotland Satellite Radiotherapy Project Board was invited to submit a Full Business Case.
