

LONG TERM CONDITIONS PLANNING FRAMEWORK 2014-15 UPDATE

Relevant changes to the national and local context

- **Health Promoting Health Service: Action in Acute Settings CEL 01 (2012)** - encouraging a move towards maximising the opportunity offered by each patient encounter to capitalise on health improvement opportunities and derive the benefits from early interventions.
- **Clinical Services Review** - and convergence with the work and clinical model descriptions coming out of the chronic disease management group, together with alignment with the clinical debate on the appropriateness of our current clinical pathways in light of current ageing population and chronic disease multi-morbidity demands on the service.

Areas which require additional or particular focus for year 2

- **Multi-morbidity approach** - development of a multi-morbidity as opposed to single disease approach , and clarity around system and process changes required to achieve this.
- **Early Intervention** - a more sustained shift from reactive to preventative care - maximising all available opportunities to achieve this.
- **Risk Profiling** - our patient population in order to facilitate the prioritising of patients to the appropriate treatment pathway at the right time.
- **Anticipatory Care Planning** - taking forward consistent and planned systems of collaborative care involving anticipatory care management, systematic follow-up and improved integration of primary and secondary care.
- **Change Fund** - evaluation of impact of intervention programmes in reducing delays and use of acute hospital beds.
