

# **Notice in terms of Article 9 of the National Health Service (Variation of the Areas of Greater Glasgow and Highland Health Boards)(Scotland) Order, 2006**

## **Scheme for the Transfer of Employees**

In accordance with the duty of publication in terms of Article 9 of the National Health Service (Variation of the Areas of Greater Glasgow and Highland Health Boards)(Scotland) Order, 2006, Argyll and Clyde, Greater Glasgow and Highland Health Boards hereby publish a summary of the agreed scheme for the transfer of all persons employed by Argyll and Clyde Health Board to Greater Glasgow or Highland Health Boards.

All staff who have a contract of employment with Argyll and Clyde Health Board which goes beyond 31 March 2006 will transfer to Greater Glasgow or Highland Health Boards, generally, as follows:

- Staff working in locations within the local authority areas of Inverclyde, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire and West Dunbartonshire will transfer to Greater Glasgow Health Board.
- Staff working in locations within the local authority area of Argyll and Bute will transfer to Highland Health Board.

For some staff who provide services across local authority boundaries, Argyll and Clyde, Greater Glasgow and Highland Health Boards have agreed on an individual basis to which Board the employee should transfer. In exceptional cases, where the attribution of staff has not been concluded, then the staff affected will transfer under the scheme, to Greater Glasgow Health Board at 1 April 2006.

All staff affected by the transfer are being notified individually as to which NHS Board they will transfer. More detailed information is available for staff and a procedure has been agreed with the recognised trade unions to deal with any difficulties which may arise.
