Emergency Referral Process To South Glasgow University Hospital

1. Migration of the Southern General

The Emergency Department and inpatient wards in the Southern General move over 1st – 3rd May 2015 into the South Glasgow University Hospital.

2. Emergency Department

The Emergency Department (ED) at the Southern General Hospital closes at 7.59 a.m. on Saturday 2nd May 2015 and the ED in the South Glasgow University Hospital opens at 8 a.m. that day.

3. Referral Process to Acute Receiving – For Patients in the *Current* Southern General Catchment Area

- **For surgical emergencies** GPs should telephone the Southern General switchboard on **0141-201-1100** and ask to be directed to the surgical page holder as at present.
- **For medical emergencies** GPs should telephone the Acute Receiving Unit on **0141-452-2929** for emergency admissions and advice.
