### **More than £4 million investment in Vale of Leven Hospital over last five years**

NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde (NHSGGC) is underlining its commitment to the Vale of Leven Hospital (VOL) with a £393,000 investment over the current financial year.

This latest round of funding takes the board's investment over the last five years to £4,302,000.
