

Haematology SACT regimes - guidance on which patients should receive seasonal influenza vaccine		
Site Specific Team	Regime	Comments
Haemopoetic Stem Cell Transplantation	ALL TRANSPLANT RECIPIENTS	At six months post-transplant or at four months if there is an epidemic. It is recommended that close household contacts receive the vaccine for 2 years or longer if the recipient remains immunocompromised. This includes children who should receive the vaccine as an injection rather than as an inhalation.
B7/ Area 5 BWoSCC	ALL SACT REGIMES	Pre chemotherapy/prior to next cycle of chemotherapy. This excludes patients with Aplastic Anaemia, ITP and Haemolytic Anaemia (non SACT) - even if on steroids.
WARD 4C / CLINIC P QEUH	ALL SACT REGIMES	Pre chemotherapy/ prior to next cycle of chemotherapy. This excludes patients Anaplastic Anaemia (non SACT)- even if on steroids.
