NHSGGC is preparing a submission to be recognised as a Carer Positive employer at the first (engaged) level.

We currently have information on our [HR Connect](#) Carer site, including contact details, policy and links to support organisations. As part of this submission, we're reviewing how our staff with caring responsibilities feel about the support provided within NHSGGC.

According to the Worklife Balance PIN 2015, a carer is 'a member of staff who is responsible for caring for a spouse or civil partner, child, parent or a person who lives within the same household (not a lodger) and work and home life can cause conflicting pressure'.
