Changes to the regulation of supervision in midwifery has provided the opportunity to adopt a refreshed approach in practice.

In NHSGGC there are currently 36 midwives with NHSGGC who can facilitate clinical supervision.

Supervisor development training is taking place on 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Dec and 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Jan 18.

Supervision sessions will be starting across NHSGGC from February 2018.
