Annual Review date

Psychology services review

A review of psychology services across NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde is to be carried out over the next few months. This will then broaden to consider psychological therapy services. A Review Group has been set up to oversee the process, jointly chaired by Jackie Kerr, Assistant Chief Officer of Glasgow City HSCP, and Neil McCallum, General Manager, Rehabilitation (Acute). This reflects the scope of the review which will cover services in both partnerships and the acute sector.

The Review Group will begin by clarifying the terms of reference, with attention given to the distinction between psychological services and psychological therapy services.

As the review progresses, staff will be kept regularly informed via Core Brief and existing line management and professional leadership channels. Later, staff engagement events will be held to provide opportunities for face-to-face discussions.

Staff will be represented on the group by Cerys MacGillvray, chair of the Area Psychology Committee, and two staff-side representatives, Andrew Gray and Mhairi Selkirk. A staff-side reference group is also to be convened. Questions and comments can be directed to the representatives or to local Lead Psychologists.
