



Food & fluid myths in hospital

Myth: Ordering meals for empty beds doesn't cost us anything FALSE

Over ordering or ordering meals in bulk without individual patient choice creates food waste on our wards.

Just one extra meal a day, ordered for an 'empty bed', costs NHSGGC £1100 a year.

We have **reduced** our unserved meal waste by **2% over the last year** and can continue to reduce our food waste by:

Offering second helpings when available on the trolley



Not ordering meals for empty beds or for patients who are nil by mouth
