Discontinuation of paper results

Further to the Core Brief issued on 27 August, staff are reminded that from Monday 2 September results for tests ordered on TrakCare from Laboratories and Imaging will only be produced electronically for acute-based services.

If you are a practitioner currently relying on paper results to trigger actions **you need to plan now** to use a paper-free approach from Monday 2 September onwards. This may involve discussions with colleagues. The most efficient approach is likely to be using the TrakCare 'Results Unsigned' tab and/or  Unsigned Results icon from the ward floor plan.
