## Introduction

This issue of Core Brief details information on Susan Manion leading our GP Out of Hours service.

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### **Susan Manion to lead NHSGGC GP Out of Hours service**

Susan Manion, Chief Officer of East Dunbartonshire Health & Social Care Partnership, has been seconded to the Board's GP Out of Hours service to provide senior leadership to the service.

The secondment, to last for a period of up to six months, will see Susan work with the Chief Executive, the Acute team and GP representatives to deliver a sustainable GP Out of Hours service, based on the recommendations from the Sir Lewis Ritchie review.

The role of Interim Chief Officer of East Dunbartonshire HSCP will be undertaken by Caroline Sinclair, who is currently the Head of Mental Health, Learning Disability, Addictions and Health Improvement Services and Interim Chief Social Work Officer.

These changes will take effect from Monday 6 January 2020.

Jane Grant, Chief Executive said: "I am delighted that Susan will provide increased senior leadership capacity to the GP Out of Hours service in NHSGGC.

"Susan is a senior leader with many years' experience both here and in England and will bring focus and drive to deliver a sustainable service for the future.
