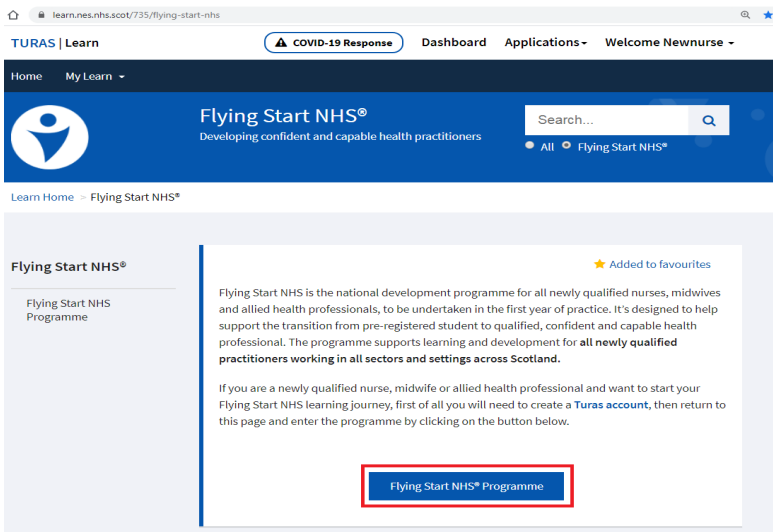

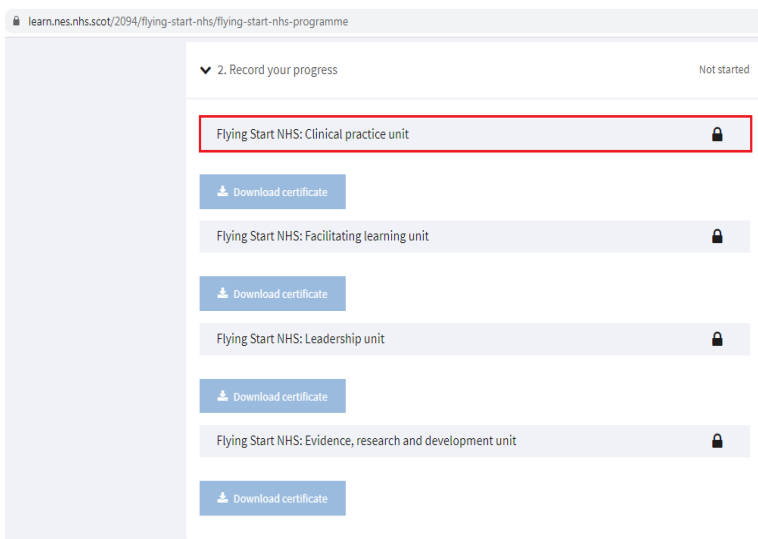
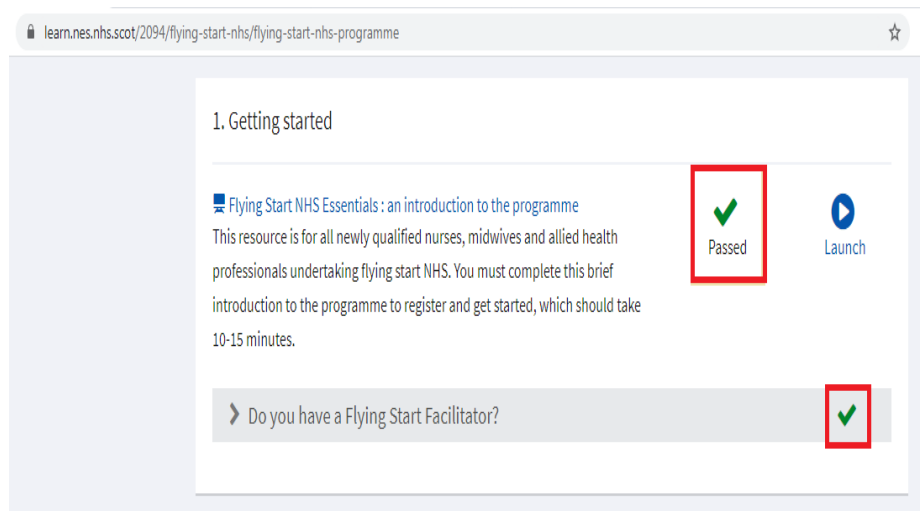
# Sign off process

Log into TURAS Flying Start: <https://learn.nes.nhs.scot/735/>



To start the sign off process, click on Flying Start link as indicated, read the information and scroll to record your progress.

**Please note:** Getting started information must be completed for you to be able to record your progress, as below.



At Record your progress, click on the grey bar, as indicated, for each pillar of Ppractice that you are ready to have signed off by your Flying Start facilitator. *Locked padlock symbol indicates you have not entered facilitator's email address to proceed.*



After clicking the grey bar, as indicated, click check box to confirm you have completed this. Enter facilitator's email address and click confirm, as indicated.

Facilitator will receive email from TURAS. This shows the attached. When facilitator is satisfied they have reviewed your evidence, they click on Sign Off as indicated.

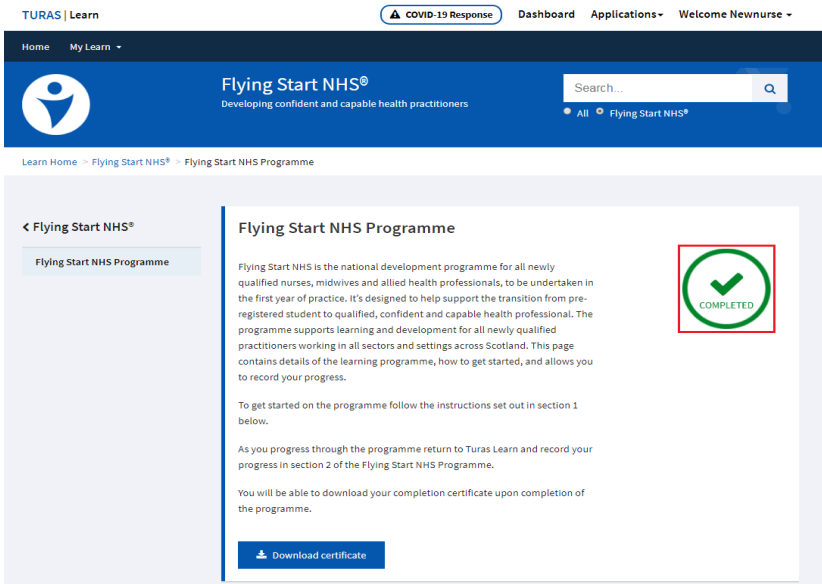

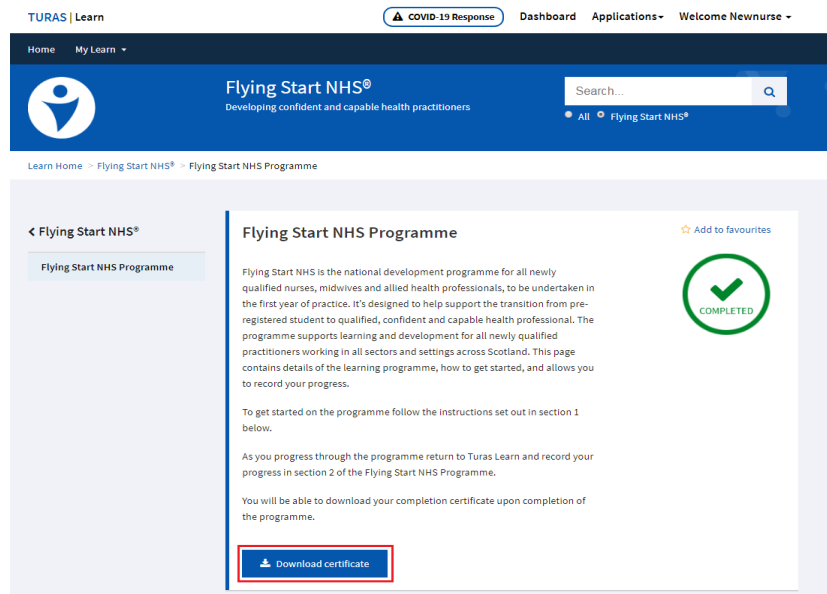
When facilitator has confirmed sign off, TURAS confirms this by email, which is sent directly to you.
